#2 Fear God

Key verse: Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God**, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. - Revelation 14:7

1. What does it means to fear God? (See Genesis 22:12)

2. What type of offering did Abraham offered up instead of his son? (Genesis 22:13)

_____ (see also JOHN 8:56-58 & John 3:16)

3. What does the Lord requires of us, and what additional information have we gathered as to what it means to fear God? (Deuteronomy 10:12-13)

4. According to Deuteronomy 6:2, if you fear the Lord you would keep His commandments, what are the benefits of obeying God? (See verses 2-3)

5. As we have seen thus far, fearing the Lord has to do with making a full surrender to Him, loving him. How is this love described in Deuteronomy 6:4-5?

6. What does the Lord wants us to do with the words that He has commanded us? (Deuteronomy 6:6-9)

7. What does Solomon says is the whole duty of man? (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14)

8. Jesus in the book of John expands on the Ecclesiastes 12:13, what is His promise to us if we love Him and keep His commandments? (John 14:15-18)

_____ (we cannot keep

the commandments with out Christ (John 15:5), but with Him we can do all things -Philippians 4:13)(without faith it is impossible to please God Hebrews 11:16)

9. In the book of Luke chapter 10, a certain lawyer asked, what must I do to inherit eternal life? What was Jesus' answer? (Luke 10:25-28)

_____(Jesus quoted Deuteronomy 6:5 and Leviticus 19:18)

10. Another lawyer asked Jesus, Master, which is the greatest commandment in the law? What was Jesus' answer? (Matthew 22:34-40)

11. Looking at the Ten Commandments, we can understand what Jesus means when he says, “on theses two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.” (See Exodus 20:1-18). (We are living in the time of the judgment (more on this in another study), therefore God is calling us to come back to Him, to love Him with all our hearts, mind and soul and our neighbor as ourselves, thereby keeping all His commandments, before it's is too late.) Are you willing, like Abraham, to surrender all to Christ? And by His grace keep His commandments?
