#1 The Everlasting Gospel

And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having **the everlasting gospel** to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, (Revelation 14:6)

1. According to Strong's concordance, what's the meaning of an "angel"?

Original: ἄγγελος

Strong's Number: G32

See all occurrences

Transliteration: Aggelos

Phonetic: ang'-el-os

Definition:

1) a messenger, envoy, one who is sent, an angel, a messenger from God

Origin: from aggello [probably derived from G71, cf G34] (to bring tidings)

Part of speech: Noun Masculine

Strong's: From α' γ γ ε' λ λ ω aggelō (probably derived from G71; compare G34; to bring tidings); a messenger; especially an angel; by implication a pastor: - angel messenger.

2. What is the significance of the angel (messenger) flying in **the midst** of heaven? (Deuteronomy 4:11-13, Revelation 8:13). _____

3. What message does the angel proclaims? (Revelation 14:6)

4. What is the gospel? And why is it said to be everlasting? (Romans 1:15-17) (Psalms 41:13)

5. How is the gospel practiced? How did Jesus demonstrated this? (Matthew 9:35, 24:14, Mark 13:10) _____

6. What was the heart of John the baptist message? (Matthew 3:1-3) (Luke 1:76-79)
